Background: This gene encodes a trafficking membrane protein which transports proteins

among the endoplasmic reticulum and the Golgi and between Golgi

compartments. This protein is considered an essential component of the Golgi SNAP receptor (SNARE) complex. Alternatively spliced transcript variants encoding distinct isoforms have been found for this gene. [provided by RefSeq,

Function: function:Involved in transport from the ER to the Golgi apparatus as well as in

intra-Golgi transport.,similarity:Belongs to the GOSR1 family.,subcellular location:Enriched on vesicular components at the terminal rims of the

Golgi., subunit: Interacts with GABARAPL2. Identified in a unique SNARE complex

composed of the Golgi SNAREs GOSR2, STX5 and YKT6.,

Subcellular Location:

Golgi apparatus membrane; Single-pass type IV membrane protein. Localizes throughout the Golgi apparatus, with lowest levels in the trans-Golgi network (By similarity). Enriched on vesicular components at the terminal rims of the Golgi.

Found in Golgi microtubules at low temperature (15 degrees Celsius). .


