Background: The protein encoded by This gene may play a role in the attachment of stem cells

to the bone marrow extracellular matrix or to stromal cells. This single-pass membrane protein is highly glycosylated and phosphorylated by protein kinase C.

Two transcript variants encoding different isoforms have been found for This gene.

Function : alternative products:Both isoforms are expressed on the cell surface.

CD34-T/CD34-F ratio increases with cell differentiation, developmental stage:On early hematopoietic progenitor cells., disease:Abnormal CD34 expression in leukemogenesis., Possible adhesion molecule with a role in early hematopoiesis by mediating the attachment of stem cells to the bone marrow extracellular matrix or directly to stromal cells. Could act as a scaffold for the attachment of lineage specific glycans, allowing stem cells to bind to lectins expressed by stromal cells or other marrow components.
