Formulation :	Supplied as solution form in 150 mM NaCl, 50 mM Tris-HCl, pH 7.5./ Lyophilized from 150 mM NaCl, 50 mM Tris-HCl, pH 7.5.
Source :	Mammalian cells
Dilution :	Reconstitute in sterile water for a stock solution
Concentration :	>90% as determined by SDS-PAGE
Storage Stability :	Use a manual defrost freezer and avoid repeated freeze thaw cycles. Store at 2 to 8 °C for one week . Store at -20 to -80 °C for twelve months from the date of receipt.
Subcellular Location :	Cell membrane ; Single-pass type I membrane protein . Exists primarily an intracellular antigen whose surface expression is tightly regulated by restricted trafficking to the cell surface and rapid internalization.
Expression :	Widely expressed with highest levels in lymphoid tissues. Detected in activated T-cells where expression levels are 30- to 50-fold less than CD28, the stimulatory coreceptor, on the cell surface following activation.
